U.S. Korean War POW/MIA Accounting Mission

~ Timeline ~

(The active mission began in 1990)

- ~ 1990-1994 North Korea unilaterally returned 208 boxes of remains
(155 American servicemen have been identified; 100 are waiting identification*)
- ~ 1996 -2005 The U.S. and North Korea conduct joint remains recovery operations
(JROs) inside the DPRK
(153 American servicemen have been identified*)
- ~ 2007 North Korea unilaterally returned seven sets of remains
(All seven American servicemen have been identified)
- ~ 2011 U.S. and North Korea meet in Bangkok, agreeing to resume JROs
(This agreement was later suspended)
- ~ 2016 North Korea received a U.S. POW/MIA family delegation
(North Korea extended an offer to return remains; declined by the U.S.)
- ~ 2018 Singapore Summit Agreement
(4th provision pledged a commitment to recover POW/MIA remains)
- ~ 2018 North Korea unilaterally returned 55 boxes of remains
(93 American servicemen have been identified; 69 are waiting identification*)
